MATCH LOCATION: NRA Whittington Center, Raton, NM 87740, John Schooley Memorial PPC Range.

ELIGIBILITY: Competitors are not required to belong to the NRA. This match is limited to 50 competitors (20 each day).

ENTRIES: Pre-registration closes at noon September 9, 2022 the day match entries will be accepted to the capacity of the range. Entry form (fillable PDF) attached on last page.

Please pay fees at the match.

***Whittington range fee of \$20.00 per shooter per day **package fee covers 1 day. Both EIC Matches and the Revolver Match will be fired on Friday afternoon and Saturday afternoon. A 2700 will be fired on both **Saturday** and **Sunday**. If you split the match into two days, there will be a total of \$20.00 as range fee to the Whittington range.**

CATEGORIES: There will be no category awards.

SQUADDING: Preference in squadding will be given to those who enter all matches. Single match or Aggregate entries will be accepted only if they do not create extra delays. New shooters are encouraged to enter the .22 Cal. 900 Aggregate, in place of the 2700. Cost of 900 is \$ 20.00

RULES: NRA rules will govern all matches. Triggers may be checked at any time during the match.

CLASSIFICATION: The NRA classification system will be used in all matches. Classifications will be verified before shooters receive their squadding tickets. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class unless there are three (3) or more unclassified competitors. In this case a special class will be provided and awards given. See rules 19.5 & 19.6. Classes will be combined if there are fewer than 3 shooters in a class. The highest class will compete for Match Winner only, if there are fewer than 3 competitors.

SCORING: All competitors will score and change targets as directed by the Range Officer. Bring your own staple gun and staples. The use of plug-type scoring gauges is restricted to range personnel and/or the Official NRA Referee only.

RELAY TIMES: Competitors are asked to pick up their squadding information beginning thirty

**CMP EIC SERVICE PISTOL MATCH
CMP EIC .22 Cal Match
Match 17 & 18**

OPEN TO: Any Resident of the United States, 16 years of age or older on the date of the match.

ENTRIES: Total number of entries is limited to 50 competitors.

DATE: Friday, Sept 9th and Saturday Sept 10th, 2022 (After the 2700 Match).

ENTRY FEE: \$20.00 payable in cash.***

ENTRIES CLOSE: Entries close at 12:00 noon, MDT, on the day of the match.

COURSE OF FIRE: CMP EIC Pistol Match Rules Apply

First Stage: Slow Fire, 50 yards. NRA B-6 50-yard target with 1 string of 10 shots fired in 10 minutes, score after 10 shots.

Second Stage: Timed Fire, 25 yards. NRA B-8 25-yard Timed and Rapid fire target. Two five-shot strings, 20 seconds per string, score after 10 shots.

Third Stage: Rapid Fire, 25 yards. NRA B-8 25-yard Timed and Rapid fire target. Two five-shot strings, 10 seconds per string, score after 10 shots.

ARM: Service Pistol as defined in CMP Rule 6.3. Standard Smallbore Pistol Cal .22 Rimfire as defined in CMP Rule 6.4. All pistols will be inspected and triggers weighed by the official NRA Referee before they may be used in this match

AMMUNITION: Pistol Competitors may use any safe ammunition that complies with CMP Rule 6.6.2 Pistol Ammunition.

AWARDS: Credit toward Distinguished Service Pistol designation. The CMP has advised that funds are not available to provide place medals as in previous years. Excellent in Competition Badges will be provided by CMP for those who qualify for this award (AF 922-10).

*** Shooters who are firing ONLY the EIC match must also pay the \$20.00 Whittington range fee.

NRA DISTINGUISHED REVOLVER MATCH - MATCH #19 THE NEW MEXICO STATE CHAMPIONSHIP REVOLVER MATCH

OPEN TO: Any competitor who is eligible under rule 2.0 of the NRA Pistol Rules. Range officers may rule juniors ineligible if they feel the junior is physically unable to safely handle an appropriate revolver with legal ammunition. Competitors are no longer required to shoot the 2700 in order to shoot this match.

ENTRIES: Total number of entries is limited to 40 competitors.

DATE: Friday, Sept 10th and Saturday, Sept 11th, 2022 (After the 2700 Match).

ENTRY FEE: \$6.00

ENTRIES CLOSE: Entries close at 12:00 noon, MDT, on the day of the match.

COURSE OF FIRE:

First Stage: Slow Fire, 50 yards. NRA B-6 50-yard target with 1 string of 10 shots fired in 10 minutes, score after 10 shots.

Second Stage: Timed Fire, 25 yards. NRA B-8 25-yard Timed and Rapid fire target. Two five-shot strings, 20 seconds per string, score after 10 shots.

Third Stage: Rapid Fire, 25 yards. NRA B-8 25-yard Timed and Rapid fire target. Two five-shot strings, 10 seconds per string, score after 10 shots.

ARM: Double action revolver capable of safely firing .38 Special ammunition as described in NRA Pistol Rules Sec. 3.1.4 (2013). Revolvers must be double action capable, have minimum 2-1/2 # single action trigger pull, symmetrical grips, iron sights, maximum 6-1/2" barrel length and use allowable ammunition listed below.

AMMUNITION: Any safe .38 caliber ammunition using the 158 grain round nose or semi-wadcutter bullet only. See *NRA Pistol Rules Section 3.1.4e (2013)*.

AWARDS: Credit toward the NRA Distinguished Revolver Badge. Awards made per Rule 23.3, NRA Conventional Outdoor Pistol Rulebook 2013.

LOCATION, HOUSING AND FACILITIES: Range location and information can be obtained at www.nrawc.org or by calling (800) 494-4853 or (575) 445-3615. Competitors are responsible for making their own lodging arrangements. The NRAWC offers log cabins and competitor housing. Inquire the NRAWC for cost of lodging. There is no food on premises at the NRAWC. If staying at the NRAWC you will be responsible for your own food. There are hotels in Raton, about 15 minutes away from the Whittington Center. There are Holiday Inn, Travelodge, Microtel, Super 8, ... There is also a number of small mom and pop's motels.
